Recording of the meeting started at 10:05.

**ACTION**

**1. Welcome and Introductions**

- (1) Cllr David opened the meeting and apologies were noted.
- (2) Cllr David welcomed Cllr Ridgewell who had joined as the new representative for Environment and Infrastructure at Caerphilly CBC. An induction session would be arranged for him with Cllr David and Clare. Cllr David expressed his thanks to Cllr Sean Morgan, the previous incumbent.

Geoff Ogden joined at 10:11.

**2. Declarations of Interest**

Cllr Wild declared an interest in item 4 as it specifically related to investment in Cardiff.

**3. Minutes from the Previous Meeting held on 4 June 2020 and Matters Arising**

- (1) The minutes of the meeting held on 4 June were agreed as a true and accurate record of the meeting, moved by Cllr King and seconded by Cllr Pratt.
- (2) Roger confirmed that all actions had been resolved or moved and updated as part of the agenda.

**4. Metro Central Update**

- (1) Roger introduced the report. He confirmed that Kellie was involved in the governance arrangements and a business case was being prepared. The potential impact on future demand due to the COVID-19 pandemic would be considered as the project moved forward.
- (2) Cllr David thanked Roger for the report and noted the close partnership with Cardiff, Transport for Wales and Welsh Government which would ensure the project was progressed.
- (3) Cllr Ridgewell asked how a workforce working from home would feed in; Roger said they were currently working through business cases and would assess this at the end of that process and before any work was carried out. Kellie said several paragraphs had been built into the business case to ensure it fed into the overall programme-level business case. Although there would be an increase they could expect to see a new blend of homeworking, office-based work and local working; there was still a very strong

case to support public transport. Cllr David agreed that even if projections were lowered there would still be capacity issues at Cardiff Central and a bigger modal shift was required in the region.

- (4) Cllr Pratt said that pollution before the pandemic was an issue due to the lack of investment over many years; one of the issues of the pandemic was that it had long-term implications. Clare said that Transport for Wales were adjusting the South East Wales Transport Model to consider different scenarios in relation to COVID.
- (5) The motion to accept the recommendation of the report was moved by Cllr Thomas and seconded by Cllr Pratt.
- (6) It was resolved that the CCRTA
  - (1) noted the update on the Metro Central Programme.

**5. Metro Plus Update**

- (1) Roger introduced the report. It was agreed that the format of Appendix A would be reviewed to facilitate easier access to the information. **CC**
- (2) Cllr David thanked Roger for his report. Cllr David noted there would always be issues with infrastructure projects but was pleased to see the progress and thanked all those involved.
- (3) Cllr David asked Kellie about the next phase; Kellie confirmed that all schemes were making progress and they would need to consider applying a timeframe; if they could continue to make good and visible progress then they would be able to go back to Regional Cabinet to make a case.
- (4) The motion to accept the recommendation of the report was moved by Cllr Young and seconded by Cllr Jeavons.
- (5) It was resolved that the CCRTA
  - (1) noted the progress of the regional programme; Metro Plus Phase 1, Metro Plus Phase 2, MEF Corridors and CVL enhancements and the indicative allocations set out at Appendices A and B.

**6. Ultra Low Emission Vehicles (ULEV) Update**

- (1) Roger introduced the report. The work was progressing and they were hoping to invite tenders towards the end of September with

an additional piece of work to bring parties together. Sites that do not come into the first round will roll forward.

- (2) Cllr David thanked Roger for the report.
- (3) Cllr Ridgewell expressed concern about ongoing maintenance as local authorities were not able to undertake this. Roger agreed it would be a significant change in terms of local authority fleets. Local authorities would need support and assistance in transitioning from a predominantly diesel fleet to a mixed fleet in the future. The disruption to the planned roadshows was disappointing and it was agreed that better promotion and explanation was required in order to maintain community support.
- (4) The motion to accept the recommendation of the report was moved by Cllr Jeavons and seconded by Cllr Young.
- (5) It was resolved that the CCRTA
  - (1) noted the progress made on the project to deliver ULEV infrastructure to assist with the delivery of the ULEV Transformation as identified within the report.

- (2) Croesawodd y Cynghorydd David y Cynghorydd Ridgewell a oedd wedi ymuno fel cynrychiolydd newydd dros yr Amgylchedd a Seilwaith i Gyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Caerffili. Byddai sesiwn cynefino yn cael ei threfnu ar ei gyfer gyda'r Cynghorwyr David a Clare. Mynegodd y Cynghorydd David ei ddiolch i'r Cynghorydd Sean Morgan, y cynrychiolydd blaenorol.

- (1) Cytunwyd bod cofnodion y cyfarfod a gynhaliwyd ar 4 Mehefin yn gofnod gwir a chywir fel y'u cynigiwyd gan y Cynghorydd King a'u heilio gan y Cynghorydd Pratt.
- (2) Cadarnhaodd Roger fod yr holl gamau gweithredu wedi'u datrys neu eu symud a'u diweddarau fel rhan o'r agenda.

**4. Diweddariad Metro Canolog**

- (1) Cyflwynodd Roger yr adroddiad. Cadarnhaodd fod Kellie yn rhan o'r trefniadau llywodraethu a bod achos busnes yn cael ei baratoi. Byddai'r effaith bosibl ar y galw yn y dyfodol oherwydd pandemig COVID-19 yn cael ei hystyried wrth i'r project symud ymlaen.
- (2) Diolchodd y Cynghorydd David i Roger am yr adroddiad a nododd y bartneriaeth agos â Chaerdydd, Trafnidiaeth Cymru a Llywodraeth Cymru a fyddai'n sicrhau bod y project yn cael ei ddatblygu.
